Soundwaves: trainee music leaders

Opportunity: a paid mentoring programme to help develop your career as a music leader working with young people in informal settings

What is the role?

Daisi (daisi.org.uk) is looking for 3 trainee music leaders who are interested in developing their skills in leading music making with young people.

You will be mentored by experienced, professional music leaders and will have the opportunity to shadow, co-lead and lead music sessions with young people, developing your skills at your own pace, with support from your mentor.

The role is 8 hours per week for 41 weeks. The fee is £122 per week. Sessions, days and training will be organised in collaboration with your mentor(s).

Background information

Daisi, the arts education partnership organisation for Devon and Torbay, is funded by Youth Music, the national charity, as part of the Alliance for a Musically Inclusive England (AMIE). Daisi is delivering the **Soundwaves** project across Devon and Torbay, which focuses on musical opportunities for young people in challenging circumstances.

Daisi's Soundwaves project is part of a drive to increase music opportunities by building a wider, more diverse workforce and building workforce skills where there are gaps in provision.

Who can apply?

Daisi are looking for people aged 18 and over who have an interest in establishing a career working as a music leader with young people. You will need to be open to working with diverse groups of young people in a variety of settings including youth clubs, community settings and health and social care settings. You will also need to be interested in developing your skills across a wide range of musical styles and genres. Daisi is committed to creating a diverse workforce and is proud to be an equal opportunities employer.
