Daisi is delivering the **Soundwaves** project across Devon and Torbay, which focuses on musical opportunities for young people in challenging circumstances. This role is part of a drive to increase music opportunities for young people in challenging circumstances by building a wider more diverse workforce and building workforce skills where there are gaps in provision.

Role description:

- To work as a trainee music leader, with mentorship from a professional, experienced music leader.
- To take part in supported leadership tasks with supervision from your mentor(s), including shadowing, joint planning, co-leading and leading sessions.
- To carry out self-reflection throughout the programme and take part in shared learning, evaluation and progress meetings with mentor(s), other mentees and Daisi.
